The themes and focus for these assembly themes have been taken from the key points in the Church of England's 'Vision for Education' document alongside the school's 5Rs for Effective Learning.

Week Beginning	Theme
7 th January 2019	5Rs Learning Behaviours: Resilience What does it mean to be resilient? How can we show this in our every day life? How do we show this in our learning?
14 th January 2019	5Rs Learning Behaviours: Respect What is respect? How does having respect improve our learning? What does the Bible teach us about respect?
21 st January 2019	5Rs Learning Behaviours: Responsibility What does it mean to be responsible? How can we be responsible learners?
28 th January 2019	5Rs Learning Behaviours: Resourcefulness What is resourcefulness? How can this help us in our day to day life?
4 th February 2019	Chinese New Year Learn about how Chinese New Year is Celebrated. Consider traditions and new beginnings.
11 th February 2019	5Rs Learning Behaviours: Reflection What does the Bible teach us about reflection? Why is it important to reflect?
25 th February 2019	Lent and Shrove Tuesday Learn about Shrove Tuesday. To think about Lent as a time of giving something back. Begin a theme of Generosity.
4 th March 2019	Generosity 1: Being Generous with Money and Possessions To encourage pupils to question is having money the most important thing in life? To learn how St David was generous with his time.
11 th March 2019	Generosity 2: Being Generous with our Talents God is generous to us, and therefore we want to share that with others. That we all have talents that we can share with others.
18 th March 2019	Generosity 3: Generosity of Spirit To consider how we can be generous in how we think about and treat each other. This is known as generosity of spirit. To think the best of people, and be willing to forgive each other when we do wrong.
25 th March 2019	Generosity 4: Be Generous to the World Around Us To consider the importance of the natural world around us to our health and well-being. Reflect on what it means to be generous to our environment.
1 st April 2019	Easter To reflect on the events leading up to Easter and what that means for Christians.
