The Governing Body's Written Statement of Behaviour Principles

At Folksworth Church of England Primary School we believe that everyone is unique and of equal worth. With this in mind, our policies for behaviour are based upon the following principles:

- Every pupil understands they have the right to feel safe, valued and respected, and to be able to learn free from the disruption of others
- All pupils, staff and visitors are free from any form of discrimination
- Staff and volunteers set an excellent example to pupils at all times
- Rewards, consequences and reasonable force are used consistently by staff, in line with the behaviour policy
- The behaviour policy is understood by pupils, staff and parents/ carers.
- Exclusions will only be used as a last resort
- Pupils are helped and/or supported to take responsibility for their actions
- Families are involved in behaviour incidents to foster good relationships between the school and pupils' home life

The governing board also emphasises that violence or threatening behaviour will not be tolerated in any circumstances.

This written statement of behaviour principles is reviewed and approved by the full governing board annually.
